John Dicks

John Dicks jokes that he missed being born at South Florida Baptist Hospital by just a few weeks – the hospital wasn't yet open. Like many Plant City residents

at the time, he and his brothers were born in the small clinic above White's Central Pharmacy.

Years later, John has made a tremendous contribution to South Florida Baptist Hospital, serving as a member of the Board of Trustees, the Foundation Board and chairman of the Planned Giving Committee.

Currently the Mayor of Plant City, John enjoys being active in civic affairs, not surprising since he is a fifth generation Plant City native. He is a seven-year member of the City Commission and a member of the board of directors and past chairman for Hillsborough Community College.

Early in his career, John practiced law with the firm currently known as Trinkle, Redman, Swanson and Coton. He received both his undergraduate and law school degree from the University of Florida. But for the last 20 years, John has been president of

Synergy Communications, a consulting firm specializing in financial and investment seminars.

John and his wife Sharon and their two sons, one a senior at the University of Florida, and the other, a sophomore at the U.S. Naval Academy in Annapolis, enjoy traveling. In August, John gave his older son an early college graduation and 21st birthday present – an "around the world and back in 18 day" trip to be remembered for a lifetime.

"We circumvented the globe," says John. The two traveled to Japan, China, Moscow, Cairo, Athens, Rome, Rio de Janeiro and London, where John had studied years earlier as law student on a semester exchange program.

Ed Swindle

As a young man in 1953, Ed Swindle was part of the construction crew building South Florida Baptist Hospital. Community support for the project was strong and each of the workers on the crew agreed to donate a day's pay to Plant City's new hospital

Little did he know that 50 years later he would still play an important role in the hospital's success. Ed's commitment to philanthropy has been a guiding principle in his life.

"We believe in the hospital and we're proud to do whatever we can," says Ed, who has been a Foundation director since early 2003. Over the years, Ed and his wife Myrtle Lou and their two sons have been strong supporters of the hospital, including providing the leadership gift for the Ed and Myrtle Lou Swindle Diagnostic Center, the hospital's outpatient center on Reynolds Street.

Ed is proud to be a veteran of the Marine Corps, a member of the First Baptist Church of Dover for over 58 years, a 30-year member of the East Hillsborough County Law Enforcement Committee and a director of the Future Farmers of American Foundation, a state-wide youth organization. In 2004, he was chosen as a Ronald Reagan Republican Gold Medal Award Winner for his "commitment to former President Ronald Reagan's vision for an entrepreneurial America."

Ed has been in the construction industry for more than 50 years and is CEO of the ESI Group, Inc., a general contractor and mechanical contractor corporation specializing in industrial insulation, sheet metal and boiler repair. In addition, he and his family have a second home in north Florida, where they have farming and timber operations.

A Tribute to Jim Redman, "Mr. Plant City"



What makes a visionary leader; someone with integrity, who inspires others to do their best, and who believes in hard work and community service? South Florida Baptist Hospital has been fortunate to have that kind of leader in Jim Redman, whose commitment to the hospital's financial stability and future growth has been exemplary.

Last year, Jim and his wife Ruby Jean presented the leadership gift to

the hospital for the long-awaited South Florida Baptist Hospital Emergency Center, now named in their honor. The Jim and Ruby Jean Redman Emergency Center will open in early 2006 to serve the greater Plant City community.

"It's a joy to help people and it was the right thing to do," says Mr. Redman. "The new ER is something the hospital has needed for many years. Having South Florida Baptist Hospital is a blessing to this community. Hospitals, besides churches, are the most necessary and most needed facilities in our community. It's a pleasure to see everything going so well and so many people involved."

"Mr. Redman's support and love for South Florida Baptist knows no bounds," says Bill Ulbricht, hospital COO. "Whether it is donating his own money, meeting with team members and physicians, or just coming to the hospital to sit in the ER waiting room at night, he challenges all of us to do more, remember our patients and set our standards very high."

Foundation Board and the hospital’s finance committee, Mr. Redman has played an important role in helping shape the hospital over the years. He was instrumental in the hospital’s decision to join the BayCare Health System, a decision that he says “looking back was the one of the best we ever made.”

“South Florida Baptist needs to grow as the community grows,” says Ulbricht. “Mr. Redman knows that the only way to do that is for the hospital to be financially stable and to be ready when that growth occurs. His vision and driving force behind the Foundation is a great example. The Foundation serves as the platform where the hospital can prepare for tomorrow through community support today.”

After receiving his undergraduate and law degree from the University of Florida, Mr. Redman returned home to Plant City and joined the law firm of what is now Trinkle, Redman, Swanson and Coton. He and Robert Trinkle have been partners in the firm for over 40 years. “Strong, decisive, informed and one of the strongest leaders the hospital has ever had; those are definitely words that I’d use

to describe Jim,” says Trinkle. “We’ve known each other since high school. He was a few years older and played a position on the Plant City High School football team that I succeeded to when he graduated.”

One of the highlights of Mr. Redman’s long career as a highly respected attorney and civic leader has been the time he spent as a state representative. He was elected to the Florida Legislature from 1966-1978 and in 1999, was the third recipient of the Ellsworth G. Simmons Good Government Award from Hillsborough County Commissioners.

“I’ve known Mr. Redman since I was a teenager,” says John Dicks, currently Mayor of Plant City. “I spent a few weeks in Tallahassee as his legislative aide, and from then on he’s been more than a mentor; he’s been the most positive influence on my life. He’s the consummate community activist. His heart has been with this community his entire life.”

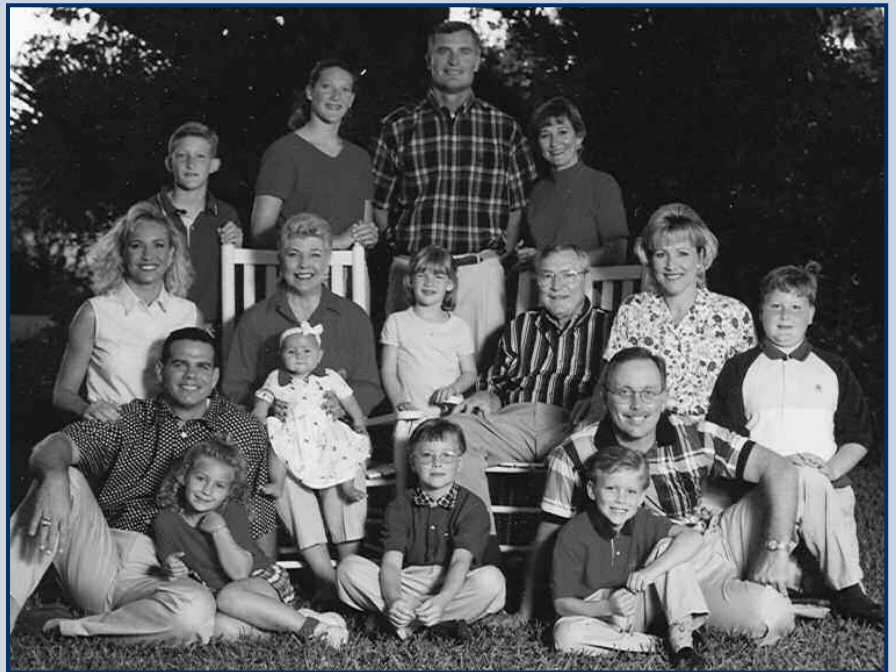
The Redman Family
